### Phoenix company, OSHA reach settlement in N.D. construction accident

MINOT, N.D. One of two companies cited in a fatal bridge construction accident in North Dakota has reached a settlement with OSHA.

OSHA had proposed fines against Phoenix-based J.D. Steel and a construction company after the collapse of a steel support structure killed a 21-year-old worker and injured three others in November.

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration says the fine proposed for J.D. Steel has been reduced from 25-thousand dollars to 14-thousand.

It says the company is making improvements above and beyond what the citation required.
