Trench collapse at university kills construction worker

ROCHESTER, N.Y. -- A construction worker died Wednesday in a trench collapse at the University of Rochester, fire officials said.

Capt. Dan McBride said 21-year-old Brandon McLane of Henrietta was working on utility lines near a residence hall around 9:50 a.m. when the walls of the trench gave way, burying him up to his shoulders.

McLane was removed after 15 minutes and died at the hospital.

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration was investigating the cause, but McBride said rain may have played a role.

The work was being done as part of a \$43 million project to have a steam plant generate hot water for heating and other power needs.
